



CRITERIA FOR POSITION – COACH

1. The Coach must demonstrate the ability to work within the NSW Touch Association “Code of Behaviour” guideline.
2. Possess the minimum active Coaching certificate (i.e. Level One or Level Two) for the competition entered, or be participating in the relevant NSWTA program to obtain it.
3. Be prepared to accept the conditions of the appointment.
4. Must possess good oral and written skills.
5. Able to demonstrate the ability to work well under pressure whilst achieving objectives.
6. Must provide a record of coaching ability and results to be assessed against the appointment criteria.
7. Successful applicant will be appointed initially for a 1-year term and is subject to review by the Norths Touch executive committee.
8. Demonstrate an ability to work within a selection team to choose final teams. This includes obtaining a minimum level 1 selectors certificate during your appointment.

STATEMENT OF DUTIES

1. To Coach the Northern Suburbs team to which the appointment was made.
2. To arrange team training sessions providing direction and developing strategies.
3. To liaise with team management regarding administrative matters.
4. To ensure the conduct of the team is beyond reproach.
5. Maintain player profiles and constantly review and monitor player performance and give individual player feedback.
6. Provide the Norths Touch Director of Representatives with regular reports when required.
7. Liaise with the Norths Touch Administrator and other team coaches/managers

CRITERIA FOR POSITION – ASSISTANT COACH

1. A knowledge of the standards and behaviour expected of a NSWTA Official and/or representative player and acceptance for these standards, or the ability to quickly acquire and apply such knowledge.
2. The Assistant Coach must demonstrate the ability to work within the NSW Touch Association “Code of Behaviour” Guidelines.
3. Possess a Level One Coaching Certificate or be participating in the Level One program.
4. Demonstrate an ability to work in conjunction with a head coach and be a part of a coaching partnership.
5. To be able to communicate effectively and with integrity with Players and Officials.
6. Ability to work well under pressure while achieving objectives.

STATEMENT OF DUTIES

1. To assist the Coach with the Northern Suburbs team to which you are appointed.
2. Be involved in developing Training Programs and goals in conjunction with the Coach.
3. Identify talented players and report on them to the Coach.
4. Negotiate a training and development plan with the Coach.

CRITERIA FOR POSITION – MANAGER

1. A knowledge of the standards and behaviour expected of a NSWTA Official and/or Representative Player and an acceptance of these standards, or ability to acquire quickly and apply such knowledge.
2. Capacity to manage (i.e. through a documented plan, organise, direct and control.) as appropriate players, gear and equipment.
3. A high degree of initiative and organisational ability.
4. Mature judgement and capacity to accept responsibility.
5. Good inter personal relationship skills.
6. The ability to work well under pressure whilst still achieving objectives.
7. Co-ordinate and collect all financial dues from teams on behalf of regional Sydney Scorpions Finance Director.

STATEMENT OF DUTIES

1. Manage the Northern Suburbs team to which they are appointed.
2. Liaise with the Coach re: organising training times and facilities.
3. Liaise with the players to ensure that all team members are aware of training and playing schedules.
4. Liaise with officials re: transport arrangements, clothing, gear, equipment, photographs.

5. Co-ordinate and manage team fund raising activities.
6. Become conversant with competition Rules, By-law, Regulations and requirements for paperwork.
7. Responsible for issuing players clothing gear and equipment.
8. Responsible for security of team valuables while playing.
9. Provide for players needs during games.
10. Provide facilities for players to obtain after match refreshments.
11. Preferred: First Aid Certificate (Current)
